The Institute of Electro-Optical Engineering was established in August 1993. It currently has 10 full-time faculty members across all areas of electro-optical engineering. National Sun Yat-Sen University established the first Department of Material Science and Optoelectronic Engineering in Taiwan and has now 19 full-time faculty members. The 29-faculty team is now executing major national projects, such as Promoting Academic Excellence Program(學術卓越計畫) sponsored by the Ministry of Education, Technology Development Program for Academia(學界科技專案計畫) sponsored by the Ministry of Economic Affairs, National Science and Technology Program for Nano-science and Nano-technology(國家奈米計畫) sponsored by the National Science Council. We have one Chair Professor who won the Outstanding Scholar Awards from Dr. Yuan-Tseh Lee(李遠哲)'s Foundation for the Advancement of Outstanding Scholarship and three Professors who won the Outstanding Research Awards from the National Science Council.
